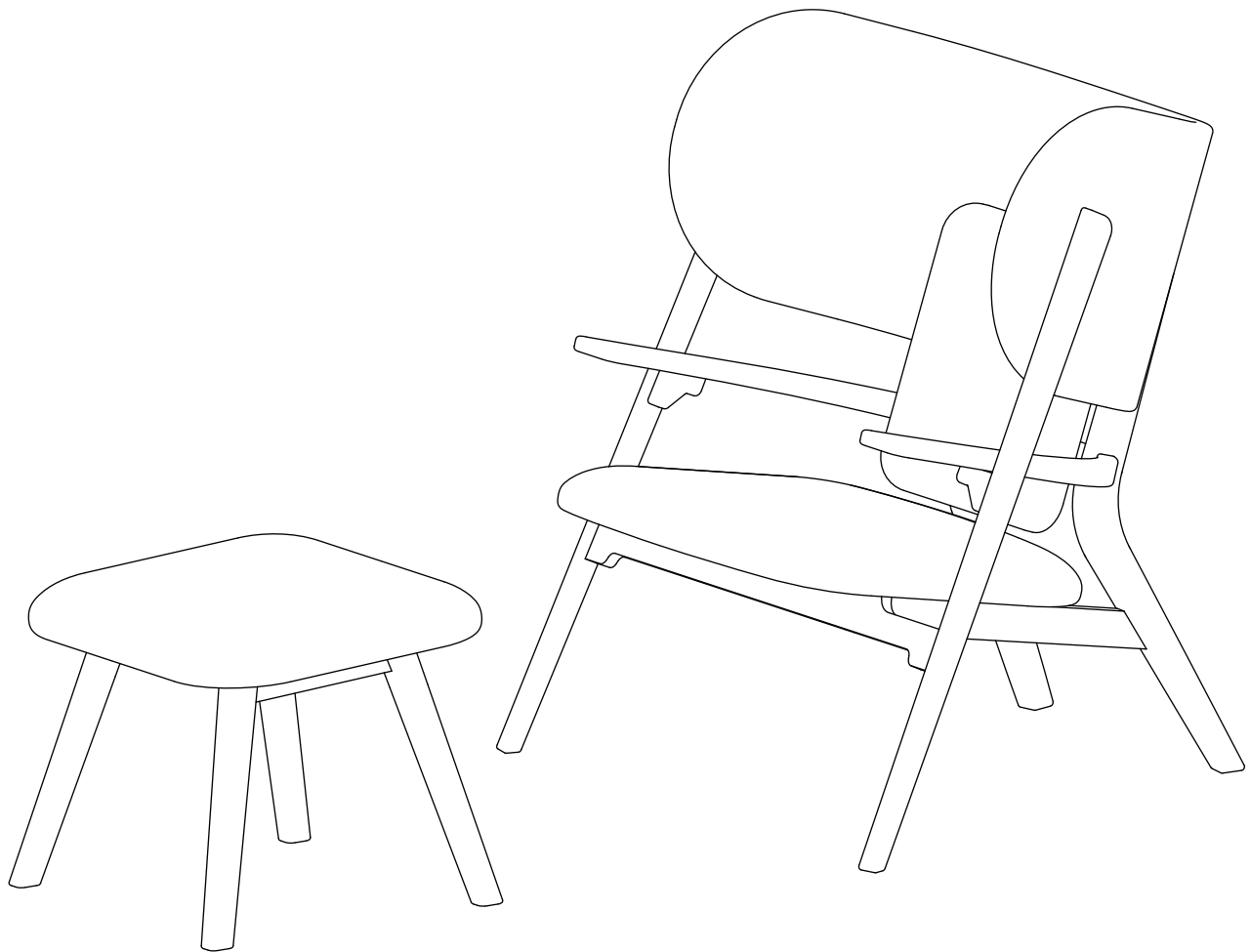

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IMPORTANT INFO

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Wood (veneer and solid wood) and color lacquer with standard finishing

Keep clean with a cotton cloth.

Remove stains with a moist cloth or with some soapy water (without glycerin) or if necessary with a degreasing cleaner.

After this, clean the surface well with clean water in order to eliminate all cleaning liquids previously used.

However, avoid the surface becoming too wet. End with a dry cloth.

Always work in the direction on the grain of the wood. Never use abrasive substances.

Upholstery

Regular cleaning is important in order to keep the upholstery textile looking its best and to prolong its life.

Dust and dirt wear down the textile and also reduce its fire-retardant properties.

Standard cleaning

Vacuum frequently, ideally every week. Use the vacuum at half power when appropriate.

We recommend that upholstered furniture in commercial environments are cleaned by professionals 2 to 3 times a year.

Specific stains

Liquids must be soaked up with an absorbent napkin or cloth.

Non-greasy stains can be removed by gently dabbing with a moist sponge or lint-free cloth. Work in circular motion towards the centre of the stain.

Always ensure the textiles is fully dry before using the furniture again. Using a hairdryer can help to avoid edge marks, particularly with microfibre fabrics.

Leather

Cleaning the leather is a delicate operation that must be performed by specialized professionals. However, there are some simple cleaning and maintenance operations that can be performed by the user:

For cleaning small superficial use a soft slightly damp cloth (in case of using any detergent, use a neutral PH detergent);

Articles in leather must be dried at room temperature away from heat sources.

Before applying any cleaning or maintenance product, test it on a non-visible part of the article.

Please note: These tips are purely recommendations and do not guarantee complete stain removal. In all cases, we recommend contacting a professional dry cleaner.
